

## Sura 93 The Forenoon (Ad-Dhuha)

### Introduction

This Sura is dedicated in its entirety to the Prophet (S.A.W), It is a message from his Lord which touches his heart with pleasure, joy, tranquillity, mercy and compassion.

Revelation, angels' visits and the link with Allah were the Prophet's whole equipments along his difficult Path to call for the Unity of God.

So, when the Revelation was withheld, the source of strength of the Prophet was cut off. Alone he was left without the companionship, it was very difficult time for the Prophet who was unaware of the reason for the revelation to be withheld. So this sura was revealed to assure the Prophet that Allah never leaves him alone but it is all the Universe that → Allah blessed him (Mohamed) with the fellowship of the world around him and also that he will get better

favours in the hereafter, than that he is getting in this life.

V. 1-2

Allah vows by these two calm and inspiring periods of time, and establishes a relationship between natural phenomena and human feelings. Thus, mutual response is encouraged between human hearts and the Universe, which is beautiful, alive and sympathetic to all living beings. Hence, heart lives in peace with the world, relaxed and happy.

During these periods of time (the forenoon and the night), one's reflection flows like a stream, and the soul is best able to communicate with the Universe and its Creator, and feels the universe worshipping its Lord and turning towards Him in praise.

V. 3.

Allah is clarifying to Prophet Mohammed (S.A.W) that

① Mohammed (S.A.W), your Lord has not left you,

now has He been harsh to you. For He is your Lord and you belong to Him. He is your sustainer and protector.

Allah's Favours on you have neither been stopped or run out.

You Mohamed (S.A.W) are to get much better favours in hereafter than you are getting in this life.

3 Allah is supporting Prophet Mohamed (S.A.W), who was having a lot of hardships in his worldly life, as Allah Messenger, calling for rejection of Idol worshipping which was the act of worship for his people, whom mostly attack him, his faith, guidance and belief. So it is

So the mercy of Allah to give the glad tidings to His Prophet that: the Hereafter (Paradise) will be more better for you, it will be the reward for all your suffering in the present life.

V: 5

Allah is saving for you, Mohamed (S.A.W) what will satisfy you in your mission and ease your hardship

and bring about the success of your call. These thoughts were in fact preoccupying the Prophet's mind as he was encountering his people's rejection and ill treatment.

### V. (6-7-8)

X The Sura goes on to remind the Prophet of his Lord's attitude towards him from the very beginning of his mission so that he will be confident that Allah will never make him to be lonely or lost even when the revelation was withheld.

1<sup>st</sup>: You were born orphan but Allah protected you.

He has made many people kind to you especially your uncle Abu-talib, though he follows a religion different from yours. 2<sup>nd</sup> You were poor and He made your heart rich with the truth, also made you rich through your business gains.

3<sup>rd</sup> You were also brought up in an ignorant

society, full of confusion of beliefs and concepts. So Allah has guided you through His revelations and the way of life, He has set which establishes a firm bond <sup>be</sup> ~~the~~ between Him and you.

(9-10-11)

As Allah mentioned His Blessings on Prophet Mohamed and reminded him of His Mercy. Allah takes that opportunity to instruct the Prophet and all the muslims:-

1<sup>st</sup> to protect every orphan.

2<sup>nd</sup> to be charitable to every beggar

3<sup>th</sup> to Speak of the great favours they enjoy from Allah, the most important of which is the guidance to the Religion of Islam.

∴ The Lessons of this Sura are :- It is Allah the Most Merciful, The Planner and The Decider who saves His Servants according to His Wisdom, as it is clear in the condition of Prophet (Mohamed)

who was a poor orphan living in a society of ignorance.

So Allah ~~opt~~ of His Power, Mercy and Wisdom, made

that orphan to be protected until he grew up and
