Importance of Duaa:-

1. Dua is an inspiration gift that our Lord has

given us, a way for His believers to communicate
to him directly to express our fear, need, hope and

as we turn to Him only because we knew that:

He alone can lift our sufferings and solve our

problems, as we feel relieved after

describing our difficulties to our Creator

we

feel empowered after having communicated

with the All-mighty

and we sense His mercy all around us after talking to the Most Merciful.

In every difficulty our first action is Duaa as it is our last. We ask Allah (S.W.T) to show us the way to handle the trials of life, we seek His Help to make that way easy for us and also we seek His Support in making our efforts successful.

We need to know that Duaa is the heart of worship (i.e.) A person engaged in Duaa:-

① Affirms his belief in tawheed (monotheism) i.e. Unity of Allah) i.e. affirms his belief that the only Power is the power of Allah and because of this reality, he is calling the Only Power (Allah) to help him to solve his problems.

2) Affirms his own powerlessness, as he can't

do anything except by the Will of Allah.

∴ Duaa is the practice of the belief of the Unity of God's Worship. A person seriously and sincerely engaged in Dua understands exactly the relationship between himself and the Lord and affirms it through his actions.

Duaa is the most important tool of the believer which can change fate while no action ever can.

Accordingly, a believer must have his clear concept regarding Duaa which is "If God grants his Servant a chance of making Duaa, He will not deprive him of answer."

The Duaa is: Our key to our spiritual happiness, offers us a certainty of hope for our future and it helps us to unburden our souls of the deepest of pains' feeling ^{only Our Creator knows}.

∴ According to the terminology of Shariaah

(Islamic Law) : AL Dua is a request from
a servant to His Lord. Supplication dictates that:
there must be a supplicant (the servant) and a
highest Answerer (Allah), All praise and glory to Him.
In his supplication, man begs for things he sees
as good for him, judged by his limited knowledge
imperfect human power and imbalanced criteria.
But Allah who alone possesses Power and Knowledge
sees that the thing, His servant begs for is in reality
good or evil for him so it is up to Allah, The Only
One who knows the truth, it is up to Him to
answer the Dua, if it will bring good, and not to
answer it and replace it by reward in the Day of Judgement

And in Surat 17. AL Isra. V.11. , Allah said:

"And man invokes Allah for evil as he invokes Allah for good,

"And man is ever hasty"

Fate of our Duaa

Prophet Mohamed (S.A.W) said :

" No muslim makes a supplication in which

there is no sin or severing of the tie of

Kinship except that : Allah gives him by

that one of three things :-

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1 He gave him what he asked immediately

or 2 He (Allah) saved for him by that

Duaa (supplication) some reward which

he will get on the Day of Resurrection.

or 3 - He (Allah) saves him from a calamity

which is equivalent to the supplication

he made.

The Companions said : we will then make

more supplication , so prophet Mohamed said :

" And Allah also will give you more. "

Conclusion : Duaa has a benefit in all conditions

Supplications as mentioned in the Sunna of Prophet Mohamed
(S.A.W)

Prophet Mohamed (S.A.W) said:

1. Allah is angry at whosoever does not ask of Him.

2. Allah loves those who are earnest and persistent in their supplications.

3. Supplication is the weapon of the believer,
the pillar of the religion and the light of
the heavens and earth.

4. Verify, Supplication is worship

5. Supplication is the essence of worship.

6. The prophet was asked by some of his companions
"Is Allah near so we invoke him or is he far so
we call him? So Allah revealed this verse 2:186 -

"Allah is near, He can hear the suppliant

anytime, anywhere and respond if the suppliant

invokes Allah with sincere heart and avoid interdictions
of supplications

Supplication (Duā) and Fate:-

Prophet Mohamed (S.A.W) said:

1. "No thing but supplication averts the decree."
2. "Caution will be of no benefit against Divine Decree."

but Dua benefits all things, whether they come down or not. I therefore advice you to make Duā, O Servants of Allah."

These informative hadith teaching us

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that :

- (1) No matter how cautious a person is, he cannot escape what Allah had decreed for him.
- (2) The willful actions of man like supplication is part of his fate which is decreed by Allah who knows that man will do it. It is the knowledge of Allah which cover all the events that take place in the Universe. Allah comprehends every thing in His knowledge.
- 3) In order to realize how Dua can repel Divine Decree

you must believe in :

1- The knowledge of Allah

and that 2- Fulfilment of any goal is dependant on

the means necessary to produce it. And both

are decreed. e.g. if I want to have a baby, I must marry.

and since 3- Dua is one of the means for fulfilling
our goals.

∴ So 4- Dua is part of one's Decree.

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This is the reality related to supplication.

A reality which will encourage every believer

to follow our prophet Mohamed (S.A.W) who

was calling upon His Lord at every moment i.e.

when he wakes up, washes up, sleeps, travels, eats

or drinks. There is no moment in the life of

prophet Mohamed when he didn't remember His Lord

and seek His help and support. There is no

wonder that all his supplications were answered including

the one he has saved for the Day of Judgement which

is: interceding on behalf of his followers.

and let us learn this Hadeeth of prophet

Mohamed (S.A.W) which proves the mentioned facts:

Prophet Mohamed (S.A.W) said to Ibn Abbas :

"Young man , I shall teach you some words (of advice) : Be mindful to Allah , and Allah will :

protect you. Be mindful of Allah , and you

will find Him in front of you . If you ask , ask
only Allah - and if you seek help , seek

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help only from Allah. And know that if

all nations were to gather together to

benefit you , they would benefit you only

with something that Allah has already

prescribed for you . The pens have been lifted and

The pages are dry.

Conclusion : As true believers , you need to do

Dua` to Allah all the time as He is the only One

to be asked for help . 2- Dua` is part of your Deen

which Allah has already prescribed for you .

As Allah said in Surat 27 An-Naml - V.62.

Sincerity

"Is not He Who responds to the distressed one, when he

calls on Him, and Who removes the evil and make you inheritors
of the earth, generations after generations? is there any
(god) with Allah? little is that you remember.

Also Allah said in Surat 72 AL-Jinn. V.18

"And the mosques are for Allah (Alone),

so invoke not anyone along with Allah."

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Also Allah said in Surat 41 Ghāfir V.14

So

"So call you (O Mohamed and the believers) upon

(or invoke) Allah making your worship pure for Him

Alone.

Regarding sincerity in supplication (Duā')

to Allah, we need to know:-

① So long as you are a believer in the unity of

Allah, so your supplication will be only to him

and your supplication will be continuous, i.e

at times of prosperity and at times of adversity

because you believe that you need His Help every second

Ways for answered supplications

1- to be sincere in your Duaa i.e:-
To cry your heart out, asking Allah
with full sincerity and full trust, for all the
things which you are missing in your life,
to ask him to remove your grief and to
bless you with what you always want, and
to ask Allah to save you from the Hell and
to make the paradise your final destination

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The secret of the Duaa to be answered depends
on the true belief that only Allah can solve
the problems and make the hopes real, the true
trust that He will answer your Duaa, the true
hope that: supplication to Allah is the only
way to avert the destiny

The more you have the above realities clear
in your mind and heart, the more you will
feel close to Allah in your Duaa. The more your
Duaa will be accepted.

of your life.

2) ∵ These who associate partners with Allah such as idols, tombs, the dead people in tombs e.g. the grave-worshippers do nowadays by refuge with the dead.

Allah does not answer their supplication because

Supplication has to be only to the One Lord i.e. Allah.

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3) The believer who fears Allah and performs his duties

to Allah at times of prosperity (obeying His commands)

fearing i.e. having Allah all the time, then Allah will consider

his obedience and answers his supplication at time

of adversity as Allah said in Hadith Qudsi: "My

servant continues to come nearer to Me through voluntary

deeds until I love him and when I love him, I become

his ears with which he hears, I become his sight with

which he sees and I become his hands with which he

strikes, I become his legs with which he strides. If

he asks Me, I shall surely grant his request, If he seeks my refuge - I shall protect him.

Prophet Mohamed said: get to know Allah
(adhere to his commands) in prosperity and Allah will
know you (help you) in adversity.

4) Those who supplicate Allah seeking mediation
^(sayyidunna)
^(E) or intercession through dead persons saying "We ask
you (Allah) by so and so or by their glory" However,
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Allah never answers their supplication because it
is a form of innovation which is invalid and
prohibited by Allah, as Allah does not allow us to use
intercessors to supplicate him. On the contrary, He has
Commanded us to call Him directly with no other
mediators.

Allah said in Surat (40) Ghaffir V. 14.

So call you O Mohamed and the believers upon
Allah, making your worship pene for him.

5) Be aware of these polytheistic supplications
that are widespread in the current times.

Ways for answered supplications

2. To have full trust that Allah will answer your supplication

Prophet Mohamed said :

"Supplicate to Allah with full confidence that He will answer you"¹⁾

This full trust in Allah is based on your belief that "He is the Only Power" and that ability

"Allah has the Power to do everything He wants."²⁾

3. To be patient:-

There are some muslims who stop supplicating to Allah, when they feel that "it is too long time and still their supplications are not answered.

In reality we need always to remember that

It is the knowledge and wisdom of Allah to

plan for every thing in this life. So the believers will always keep on doing Duaa to Allah in patience

and with full confidence that: the Most Merciful

the All-Knower is planning the best for us and will answer our supplication in the best time for us.

Prophet Mohamed said "Verily, Allah loves those who are persistent in ^{supplication}".
Prophet Mohamed said: the invocation of anyone of

you is responded to by Allah (SWT), if he does

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not show impatience by saying: 'I invoked Allah (SWT) but my request has not been granted'.

4- To obey Allah's commands and obligations

upon you, and to avoid doing what He had

forbidden. as Allah said in Surat 10. Yunus V. 91

91 "Now (you believe) while you refused to believe before and you were one of the evil doers".

5- To ^{use} lawful food, drink and clothing i.e.

to earn Halal (Lawful) money. Prophet Mohamed (S.A.W)

said: "Make your food (Lawful) then your Dua'i will be answered".

6- To have full concentration while you make

Dua'i i.e to avoid being heedless, as

prophet Mohamed (S.A.W) said :

"Supplicate Allah and bear in mind that He will surely answer you, and be aware that Allah never answers the supplication of someone who is heedless."

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→ To enjoin what is right and to forbid evil (what is wrong).

Prophet Mohamed (S.A.W) said :

"You should enjoin what is right and forbid what is wrong, otherwise He (Allah) will descend punishment upon you, and then you will ask Him, but your Supplication will never be answered."

Let everyone of us, revise this rule and check himself regarding its reality.

8. To be always humble to Allah and to show your need to His Help and Your desire to His bounty.

1-

To supplicate at times, when Duaa is more likely accepted.

Month of Ramadan constitutes the time of bringing oneself into perfect harmony with Allah's Way, as ^{during} Allah in Ramadan you experience an overwhelming state of obedience to Allah i.e abandoning your food, drink and conjugal relations in obedience to Allah, and closing all the ways of Shaitan to your spirit. Through this straight faithful behaviour, you elevate your spirit to a state of utmost sincerity in unity with Allah's Will. Accordingly, there will be no limit for the grace, that Allah may bestow upon you i.e. answering all your supplications.

^{Look}
This is the Month of Ramadan, but we need to know that Lailatul Qadr is the best night for answering the Dua (last for it in the last 10 nights of Ramadan. It's Dua is "O Allah, You are pardoning and you love to pardon so pardon us".

② After the obligatory prayers,

Prophet Mohamed said about the
which Duaa is most likely to be answered?:

In the depth of the last part of the night
and after the obligatory prayers.

③ In The last Part of the Night

Prophet Mohamed said : Our Lord descends every
night to the lowest heaven, when the last
third of the night remains and He says " Is
there anyone to invoke Me so that I may respond
to his invocations? Is there anyone to ask Me for
something so that I may grant him his request?
Is there anyone to ask for forgiveness so that I
may forgive him?

④ Between Aathan and Iqama

Prophet Mohamed (S. A. W) said : The invocation
is not rejected between Aathan and Iqama
so do invoke "

5- On Jumuah

According to prophet Mohamed (S.A.W), there is an hour of Jumuah (in which Dua'a' is accepted).

So let us try to spend the day in remembrance of Allah and invoking Him.

6- In Prayer After At-Tashahud:

Abdulla - Ibh Masoud narrated : I was offering prayer while the prophet, Abu Bakr and Umar were together. After I sat for the last Tashahud, the prophet said : ask you will be given, ask you will be given.

7- When prostrating

Prophet Mohamed said "The closest a person gets to his Lord is by sujood (prostration). Therefore, increase Duaa."

∴ One must try to invoke Allah in every prostration.

- On the Day of Arafa

Prophet Mohamed said:

The best supplication is the supplication on
the day of Arafa.

- The One who is suffering injustice.

Prophet Mohamed said:

Beware of the supplication of the unjustly treated,
because there is no shelter or veil between it
and Allah S.W.T.

- The Traveller:

Three supplications will not be rejected:

- 1- the one who is fasting.
- 2- The oppressed
- and 3- the traveller.

- During the rain.

Prophet Mohamed said:

Two supplications will not be rejected, supplication
after the Adhan (call for prayer) and at the time of rain.

Manners of supplication (Dua)

- 1- It should start with : Bismillah , Praise is to Allah and Peace and blessings be upon the messenger of Allah.
 - 2- It should be performed secretly and with sincere heart.
 - 3- It should be with humility and express your need of Allah.
 - 4- It should be repeated three times.
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- 5- Invoke Allah by His Names and Attributes.
 - 6- Supplicate Allah (SWT) by mentioning the righteous deeds you have done.
 - 7- Admit your sins during the supplication.
 - 8- Face the Qiblah during your supplication
 - 9- Do not be aggressive when you are supplicating Allah.
Such as asking Him to make you a prophet.
 - 10- When making supplication for others, start with yourself then include others. Revise sunnah(I.) V.28 .
 - 11- Remember to include your parents in your supplication

At the end, we have to know that 'Supplication (Du'a) is from the most beneficial types of healing. It is the enemy of affliction and illness, repressing them, treating them and preventing their occurrence. Prophet Mohamed (S.A.W) said: "While the tribulation is descending, the supplication meets it and they remain struggling with one another, until the Day of Judgement."

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So let us have this medicine which Allah the Most Merciful blessed us with, let us have it all the time as a fundamental bond with the Lord.

Let us always live our lives with the full trust that so long I am following the commands of Allah, living Islam as a way of life - and having the Du'a as a continuous bond with my Lord, I have full trust that I will live my life in the best shape ihsa'Allah.
