"The ways to Allah's mercy"

Q what is the meaning of being merciful to all around you?

A

Mercy is a sign of humility. it also removes arrogance.

Mercy means showing understanding, help and sympathy,

i.e the feeling of concern about people's affairs,

sharing their pains and aspirations and also coming

to their aid. Your parents, wife or husband, your kids

your relatives, your neighbours, your muslim

community, all humanity and any living creature
e.g plants and animals, all are in need of mercy.

So logically, it (Allah's mercy) has to be
the goal for every believer.

and let's learn the following verses:-

Allah's mercy: Surat 6 (155) - Surat 7 (V-52 and

- Belief in Unity of Allah, ^{obedience} ↑ Fear of Allah (taqwa) as

- Obedience of Prophet Mohamed (S.A.W) is also a source of Allah's

The ways to Allah's mercy:

1- The Holy Quran: The Book of Allah

The careful student of the Quran is bound to find an amazing wealth of statements and directives in the Quran which is an ocean of knowledge.

The Quran takes man as a complete entity and explains his origin-potentials, fields of action, reactions, responses as well as his inner self.

Biology, psychology, education and religious studies address certain aspects of these.

It is also the unique approach of the Quran, as it takes human nature by the hand and moves it up gently, step by step, yet with much energy and clarity of vision. It gives the human spirit, the true knowledge, firm reassurance, consistency of action and a clear and relaxed awareness of the fundamental truths of existence.

The fact is: The One who has revealed the

Quran is the Creator of man, who knows

His creation. He is closer to man than his

- Jugular vein.

It is the Quran that has a unique and overpowering
(attraction)

appeal to human nature in everything it says.

Allah challenged humanity to produce anything

similar to the Quran as it always remains

a book of superior excellency.

But beyond all this, the subject matter of

the Quran claims its outstanding strength, as

Allah said in Surah AL ARAF V. 203.

The Quran is a means of clear insight,

providing true guidance and abundance

mercy and blessing for true believers.

The Quran is responsible by Allah's will

for a great mercy in human spirit as it

touches it directly, provides it with the hope, reassurance, tranquillity and peace which are the fundamental needs for the healthy, balanced, active, happy and living spirit. This is the mercy of Allah, which you can feel it in the inside depth of your spirit, when you come to the Quran, with:

- ① The Belief in its unique method in presenting the truth of existence to human nature (The Book of truth)
- ② The Intention to realize and understand its message and to follow its rules, as it is the message of guidance from the Lord of heavens and earth

∴ Rule: for every muslim believer who is looking for the Mercy of Allah to fill his heart with the hope and tranquillity and reassurance, you must come to the Quran with these states of consciousness:

1. Say to yourself: I am in Allah's presence.
2. Say to yourself: I am hearing from Allah,

as the Quran is the speech of Allah.

3. Say to your self: Allah addresses me directly when I read the Quran.

4. Say to your self: Every word of the Quran is meant for me.

5. Say to yourself: when I read the Quran, I have a conversation with Allah.

6. Say to yourself: Allah will surely give me all the rewards from reciting the Quran in the form of healing, cure, light and guidance in this life and in form of good deeds in hereafter.

At that point, you will wish Allah feel that your spirit is so attached to these words of your lord.
As these Quranic words pour into your spirit all the knowledge, guidance, solutions, wisdom, clarifications and Proofs for all the matters around you. Immediately, the Quran will become the source of mercy and grace to your spirit.

and you will be always looking for it all the time, to be close to you. As at the time of adversity, it is the shelter and the cave where you can have the rest, hope, protection and peace of mind. and at the time of ~~prosperity~~ prosperity, it will be the Reminder for you to thank The One who is the Source of all your happiness and prosperity.
