"Let's support each other"

- Insha Allah, today - we will continue to learn about the characteristics of the believing heart from the verses of the Quran.
- Today we will learn about these characteristics from Sura (9) - V(71)
 - 1) Helpers and supporters of one another.
 - 2) They enjoin what is right and forbid what is wrong.
 - 3) They attend to their prayers.
 - 4) They pay their Zakat.
 - 5) They obey Allah and his messenger.
- To know about the importance of Love
and loyalty as characters of the believing heart - let's recite the following verses of the Quran :-

Surat (3) - (103) : There are ⁴ rules in this verse

① ← In this verse, there is a command from Allah (SWT) for the believers to adhere closely to the "Bond of Allah" together and not to be divided. This "Bond of Allah" is the religion of Islam, and the promise that Allah (SWT) has taken upon the believers is that; they ^{must be} brothers and sisters and they ^{must} love one another, ^{and} when they will do the above - this means that they

activate the bond of Allah.

② ← Allah (S.W.T) then asks the believers to remember how they were enemies, and He united their hearts so they became supporters and helpers to each other.

③ ← Allah counts this a great blessing and favor that He had ~~done~~ for the believers. This shows how important indeed this bond is. It is so important that Allah (SWT) is counting it as a great blessing that He bestowed about the believers.

④ Allah The Allmighty then informs us that this unity
is what saved them from falling into the fire.

Therefore doing the contrary, which is to be disunited,
to hate each other, to be divided into groups and
to take the sense of unity among themselves, this
will cause them to fall into the fire.

- Also in Surat (8) - (V 46), There is a command for unity.
~~and the Love which is based on the belief in Allah's Oneness not for the benefits~~
Also There are many Ahadith from the Sunna of

Prophet Mohamed (S.A.W) that encourage the attitude
of support, help and unite between Muslims

Prophet Mohamed (S.A.W) said :-

1. "The believer to the believer is just like a
building, its parts support each other."

2. The example of the believers in the
Compassion and mercy, they have to each
other is the example of one body, if a part
of it falls ill, the rest of the body suffers with
fever.

③ You will not enter Paradise until you believe, and you will not believe until you love one another.

④ " you will not be a believer until you love for your brother what you love for yourself.

[A clear proof of the great importance of the love between the believers] as it is a must for being a believer.

⑤- Allah will say on the day of judgement:

Where are those who loved each other for my sake? I will shade them today, when there is no shade but mine.

This is a great reward for those who love each other

for (Allah's sake) - as the Day of judgement is a very long and tough day as the sun

will be very close and every one will be

looking for a shade to protect him from the heat, but there will be no shade

except for those whom Allah gives them the

shade, and from them are those muslims who love each other for Allah's sake.

↳ (6) "Whoever relieves a calamity that has struck a believer in this world, Allah will relieve for him one of the calamities of the day of judgement, and whoever makes things easy for a person in trouble, Allah will make his matters easy in this life and in the hereafter, and whoever shields the faults of a muslim, Allah will shield his faults in this world and in the Hereafter, and Allah will help and support his servant as long as he is helping and supporting his brother.

This hadith is a very encouraging hadith for every believer to help, support, relieve calamity and shield his brother or her sister in Islam.

Allah The Most Merciful is rewarding those good believers who feel the pangs of their brothers and sisters in Islam, Allah is rewarding them a great reward in the Hereafter.

↳ Actually sister, we must realize that: On the Day of Judgement, every person will be looking for good deeds to be her way to the Paradise, and imagine that you ^{can} find a lot of good deeds on that serious day, a lot of good deeds that can make the Paradise your final destination and when you ask Allah about the source of these good deeds. He The All-Knowing will inform you: that: these good deeds are your reward for your help for sisters so and so when she was in trouble and your support for sister so and so when she was sad and your relief of the calamity of sister so and so

In reality, these were very simple deeds in the worldly life, but their reward is great on the day of judgement.

So let's realize that: when you help support, relief the calamity and unit with your sisters - you are not giving them a favour, in reality you are giving the favour to you self as you are collecting a lot of good deeds for the Most Serious Event in our lives: The Day of judgement.

← Prophet Mohamed (S.A.W) also told us how to become the most beloved to Allah:

Q Would you like to be one of them?

A The way to achieve this is to help people bring them benefit and happiness and relieve them of their problems, as Prophet Mohamed (S.A.W) said.

7) The most beloved people to Allah (S.W.T) are those who help and benefit others the most, and the most beloved actions to Allah (S.W.T) is pleasure and happiness that you cause to enter the heart of a muslim, or to solve one of his problems, or to pay off his debt, or to prevent him from being angry, and working to help his Muslim brother (sister) is more beloved than making Iktaf in this Masjid for a month and whoever strives to help fulfill a need for his muslim sister (brother) Allah will make his feet steadfast on the day of judgement.

So again sisters, your reward is great like the Love and Pleasure of Allah and peace on the Day of judgement so long you consider every muslima as your real sister.

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
