#### The Answered supplications of Prophet Ayoub (Job) 3

27 July 2009

"Do not despair over what had eluded you"  
(On Allah, we rely)

benefits of belief in al-qadar

All praise to Allah, The Most Merciful,

Last week we learn about "the belief in Allah's

Decree - Insha Allah This week, we will learn about

the benefits of the belief in al-qadar (Allah's destiny)

and also we will learn about distress in our life

as part of Allah's Decree from the rules of the Quran.

They are the hardships, disasters and tribulations that

happened on the earth, or happened to the individual

or to his wealth or family, they all happen by the  
will and decree of Allah, they all can be called "distress")

This distress is part of our worldly life test. We all are

in need to Learn Allah's Laws regarding distress so that

We can follow these rules and be saved.

let's start with surat ALKAFF 18 (V 23-24), Allah said

2 Never, say about anything "I shall do this tomorrow without adding, "If Allah so wills".

This is an order from Allah not to pre-judge the future or its events because the matter is up to Allah's will, the only Power in life.

It is impossible for man to know what may happen in the future as it is controlled by Allah's Will, which man has no knowledge about it

∴ Rule ① No one can give definite judgment of tomorrow

Facts : Always remember that: the curtains hiding the future are checked in full so as to hide everything beyond the present moment. There are the curtains of the Unseen, which Allah only has its knowledge, and Allah controls it by "His Will"

∴ Conclusion ① Human being must never say he

is definitely doing something tomorrow, unless he

attached his intention to Allah's Will.

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(2) Man must not make any assertion about tomorrow

(3) In practice : every person should think and  
wish

plan as they think , but they must always remember that  
Allah's Will is the only effective Power in life so there

are always two possibilities for every desicion or  
intention

(A) If man intends to do whatever he wants ( seeking Allah's help , feeling that Allah's will is in full control of everything ) , then should Allah helps him to effect put his desicion and intention into action , then all well and good.

(B) but it may be also that Allah may decide something different to what he intends , then he should not despair or be sad . All

matters belong to Allah at the begining and at the end , and all Allah's Decree is good for the believed

We submit to Allah's will, because it is beyond our knowledge ;

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Let's have an example of the correct practice of the mentioned belief in Allah's will and Allah's Decree. 2 men applied for a job in Austin, they studied for the interview and were looking forward for it. Unfortunately, when they reached the airport, they were informed about "a delay for 4 hours" as the weather is not suitable for flying into Austin, there are seven thunder storms. This means

that . They will miss the interview, as they will reach Austin by 4 PM (The interview finishes 3:30 PM).

Both of them were not expecting that they may lose this excellent opportunity just because of the bad weather, but it is the Will of Allah.

so one of them (muslim by name only, no belief in Allah's decree) became very upset, angry and frustrated, trying to catch any other way to reach Austin in time but none. He returned home so angry with Allah's Decree, saying to his wife: it is always that Allah wants me to miss the good opportunity, why the thunder has to be sever today, at the time of the interview ?? why I can't have the interview? why it is always me? why others (in Austin) can get the job? why all my dreams will never become real? I am not happy with my life!!

I don't want to pray any more - so long Allah is against me ?? I will not try to look for a job as I am sure that Allah will always be against me I hate everything: ① Total despair of Allah's Mercy  
② full rejection of Allah's decree

∴ In Conclusion: That muslim clarified to Allah that he doesn't believe in His Decree → total loss, failure / miserable worldly life + punishment in Day of Judgment in the Test of life, i.e.

But the other Muslim, who is a believer in Allah's decree and he was also looking for the job - but he knows it that: nothing can be done except by Allah's will. So he realized that it is Allah's will that he will not appear in the interview in Austin, i.e. no job.

Immediately he remembered the rules of the belief in Allah's decree: (1) No one can change

Allah's Will, which

is the only effective Power in the worldly life

(2) All. Allah's decree is

good for the believer.

So he said to himself : All Praise to Allah,

I am sure that Allah chooses the best for me.

If Allah prevents me from reaching Houston and

appearing in the interview, This means that

it was not a successful trip and I would not have

the job. All praise to Allah. I will return home - take

rest and start looking for another job fair.

This is the true belief that Allah's will controls everything as Allah has all knowledge - wisdom and power.

∴ We need to remember "if Allah so will"

before any word related to the future, a Quranic rule which has a lot of good effect on the spirit

i.e ① Always do not give any definite judgement

regarding any decision, plan or action

in the future, be ready for any possibility as

it is Allah's will that controls, it is not your will.

② Be content - reassured and having internal

peace that all the matters from Allah are

good for the believer.

③ Do not be lazy, do not despair of Allah's

mercy, do not be disinterested, on the contrary, have

more strength, confidence and reassurance that you rely on Allah's Will and mercy and you are sure that everything is for your good.

Again, never forget "If Allah so wills"

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make it at the beginning of every statement related to the future.

Personal advice: always tell to yourself:

"Myself, I know your limitations regarding knowledge, power and wisdom, myself <sup>we</sup> are very emotional, short sighted, having little knowledge and experience in life, So it is the greatest mercy of Allah (The All knowledge, Power and Wisdom) to be the One to decide, plan and choose for you. Myself, I am content with all that Allah chooses for me and decides for me even if it is opposite what you like, I am very appreciating to Allah that He is the One to get me out of the responsibility of blaming you for ~~any~~ <sup>any</sup> wrong decision."

Instead, I never have the guilty feeling of wrong decisions in life. I believe that Allah chooses the good and I try to accept all Allah's decree and to accommodate it with all the trust and hope in Allah.

It is the advice and command of Prophet Mohamed (S.A.W) which we need to remember whenever our plans are ~~crossed~~ <sup>crossed</sup> in different directions of what we planned:

(2) The example of a believer is that of a fresh tender plant. From whatever direction wind comes, it bends it. But when the wind becomes quiet, it (the plant) becomes straight again.

(1) The strong believer is better <sup>and</sup> more beloved to Allah than the weak believer and there is goodness in both.

Strive for what benefits you - seek help from

Allah and do not despair, if a mishap should

happen to be fall you, then do not say "If only I had  
acted such and such, it would have happened such and  
such. Rather say," Allah has decreed and He does  
what He wills" for verily "if" initiates Satan.

Applying this Hadith to the previous story is  
clarifying that the first man was believing "if"

so Satan controls his reaction to Allah's Decree  
completely, leading to despair and sadness

But the second man, a believer in Allah's decree,  
was proving his belief by accepting Allah's decree,  
planning to be a strong believer, trying again, and  
again for the job - with all the hope in Allah's  
mercy

Let's now learn about the meaning  
of the <sup>Hadith</sup> of Prophet Mohamed

(S.A.W) which is related to the  
belief in Allah's Decree.

2nd

Let's Learn this hadith which will prove that:

all matters in our life are up to Allah's Decree (Allah's will) and that no one can escape whatever Allah had decreed for him,

On the authority of Abu Abbas Abdulla

the son of Abbas (may Allah be pleased with them both)

who said:

One day I was behind the Prophet (S.A.W) and he said to me.

Young man, I shall teach you some words (of advice):

Be mindful of Allah, and Allah will protect you. Be  
mindful of Allah, and you will find Him in front of you

If you ask, ask of Allah and if you seek help,

seek help of Allah. Know that if the Nation

were to gather together to benefit you with anything,

it would benefit you only with something that

Allah has already prescribed for you, and that if

They gather together to harm you with anything, they  
would harm you only with something Allah had  
already prescribed for you. The pens have been lifted  
and the pages have dried.

In another version

Prophet Mohamed (S.A.W) said: Be mindful of  
Allah, you will find Him before you. Get to know  
Allah in prosperity and He will know you - in  
adversity. Know that what has passed you by,  
was not going to befall you and that what  
has befallen you was not going to pass you by.

And know that victory comes with  
patience, relief with affliction and  
ease with hardship.

This is the rule of the belief in

~~Myself~~ Allah's Decree, so let us learn  
benefits of the belief in Allah's Decree
