Prophet Adam and Prophet Nuh

Insha Allah we will start to learn about the accepted supplications in the Quran and in the Sunna of Prophet Mohamed (S.A.W)

Today insha Allah we will start with the first Prophet i.e Prophet Adam and we will follow chronically with all Prophets, so the next will be prophet Nuh, and insha Allah, we will learn about his accepted supplications from the Quran.

Let us all learn these accepted supplications so that we can learn the strategy of supplications and we can use the same supplications in our life, while we follow the conditions for the Duaa to be accepted so that insha Allah, our Duaa will be accepted

(1) . All Praise and thanks are to Allah, The Lord of the Universe

Our worldly life is full of trials and hardships because it is a test. The more hardships you are stricken with, the more is the need to Allah The Exalted to call on and have trust in Him. Allah, Our Lord, the Only Power and Will, to Him only belongs the dominion of the heavens and the earth. We should seek refuge with none but Him Only. Allah, The Most Gracious promises never to let one's hand raised up for supplication be empty.

So it is the mercy of Allah to open for us the gates of Duaa to Him in every second ^{every} and Place so that we can receive the peace, hope, calmness, tranquillity, reassurance and the reward.

"The accepted supplication of forgiveness - Prophet Adam and his wife Eve."

The supplication: Surat AL ARAAF (7) (23).

"They said: Our Lord! We have wronged ourselves, and unless You grant us forgiveness and bestow Your mercy upon us, we shall certainly be lost."

The answer: Surat ALBAQARA (2) V. (37)

"(Proof of acceptance)"

"Then Adam received from His Lord words. And his Lord pardoned him (accepted his repentance).

Verily, He is the One who forgives (accepts repentance)

The Most Merciful.

The event: Surat AL ARAAF (7) From V (19 - V 22) →

This is the story of the accepted supplication of Prophet Adam and his wife (Hawa).

Adam and his wife lived in the Paradise, and had been allowed access to all the fruits of Paradise with the exception of one tree, which Allah

4 had forbidden them from touching it, but ^{ai}Shaitan (Allah's enemy), but Shaitan misled them so they tasted the tree, and forgot their covenant with Allah. Now they realized that they were disobedient to Allah. So they (1) admitted their mistake and recognized their error (as they have wronged themselves by being disobedient to Allah's Commands).

(2) Regretted their mistake

(3) Asked for repentance and forgiveness.

(4) Called for Allah's mercy.

(4) Clarified that, unless Allah helps them and bestows His Mercy on them. Otherwise they are lost.

The lesson is:-

- 1) Human beings sometimes forget that: Shaitan is their main enemy, so they listen to his whispers and disobey Allah's commands, then they realize that in reality they had wronged themselves so they seek forgiveness of Allah.
- 2) We must believe that Allah is All forgiving accept all the repentance.

5) 3) ∴ It is the lesson that whenever you disobey Allah →

you must : recognize your error and regret your mistake
then ask for Allah's forgiveness with all sincerity that you
will never repeat the mistake again. And always hope
for Allah's acceptance of your repentance.

So let us memorize these words of the
Quran to use them as Dua to Allah to
Forgive our sins

" O Our Lord, we have wronged ourselves,
and unless you grant us forgiveness and bestow your
mercy upon us, we shall certainly be lost."

This is the accepted supplication
of Prophet Adam (the first of man kind) and
his wife.

A lesson to every believer to call
on Allah always for forgiveness and mercy.

The answered supplications for those who have been overcome

Supplications of Prophet Noah

Prophet Noah has answered supplications in the Quran
Let's first know shortly the story of Prophet Noah

with his people and the reason for his supplications.

In Surat Noah, Allah the Almighty said in (V. 1 → 22)
(71)

This is the story of Prophet Noah with his people, He addressed people with kindness and in a friendly and patient way, trying to clarify to them the truth i.e (belief in none but Allah). He maintained his noble attitude with them for 950 years, trying all the Logic, kind and encouraging ways. Unfortunately they rejected him completely and only (9 or 11) people followed him over his long time call to Allah (950 years).

Until it was Allah's message to Noah in Surat Hud (11) 36

36 "None of your people will believe now apart from those who have already accepted the faith".

6" So at that point, Prophet Noah invoked Allah with

6 supplications, which were all answered:

The four detailed - answered supplications of Prophet Noah:

• Two supplications were to overcome his people.

• One supplication was ~~to~~ against his people

• One supplication was to save him and the believers who are with him.

In details:

The two answered supplications of Prophet Noah

to Allah to overcome his people.

↓
The first supplication is in Surat Al Muimnun V. 26 ⁽²³⁾

The supplication: "Noah said" O my Lord! Help me because they deny me"

→ The answer is in Surat Al Muimnun V. (27)

• "So We revealed to him" contrast the ship under Our eyes

and Our guidance - Then when Our Command comes and water gushes forth from the oven, take on board of each kind (male, female) and your family except those against whom the word has

already gone forth"

It was the great Flood that swept away everything,
the answer to Prophet Noah supplication to overcome
his people and in order to save him and the believers
with him, Allah revealed to him to build the ark
to save all types of animals, birds and plants
that were known to Noah at that time.

→ The second answered supp of Prophet Noah to
Allah to overcome his people was in Surat

Al Qamar (54) V. (10)

"Then he invoked his Lord saying: I have been overcome so help me"

The supplication was answered by Allah.

The answer is in the same Surat (Al Qamar) V. 11-12

"So we opened the gates of the heavens with
water pouring forth. And we caused springs to
gush forth from the earths"

The Event

(8) It was the wads of Noah People in V(9) of the same
Sura ALQamar (54), which upsets him and made him
to raise his hands to The All Powerful Allah to ask
His Help, His Support, His Revenge and His Punishment
against those arrogant, ignorant oppressors and it
is the justice of Allah to accept the supplications and
to punish them severely as (1 He opened the gates of
the heavens with water pouring forth) and at the
same time (2 caused the springs to gush forth
from the earth - so the water from the heavens
and earth to meet to make water wavelike
mountains, that covers everything, but Noah
ark and those above it

Again, these 2 supplications are general supplications
for those whom the people are oppressing
them so they can call on the All Powerful to
overcome them.

(9) And if we compare the 2 supplications, we will notice that it is the same arabic word used by prophet Noah in both of them: قُلِّبْ : help me, make me to have Victory (power) over them, make me to have and the same meaning in word $\text{رَبِّهِ$, so help me, Show them Your (Power).

Actually these are 2 powerful supplications for any oppressed person or the one who have been overcome.

The third accepted supplication of Prophet Noah is the one against his people.

The Supplication is in Surat Noah (#11) V(26) (27)

The Supplication:

" And Noah said "My Lord! Leave not one of the disbelievers on the earth. If you leave them, they will mislead Your slaves, and they will beget none, but wicked disbelievers"

The answer is in Surat Noah (71) V. 25

The Answer

"Because of their sins, they were drowned, then were made to enter the Fire. And they found none to help them except Allah"

AL Qurtobi states that Noah عليه السلام invoked

Allah, the Exalted against his own people, when he lost all hope in having them to believe in his religion when Allah revealed (And, it was revealed to Noah:

"None of your people will believe except those who have believed already"). Surat Hud (11) V. (36),

So Allah answered his supplication and caused the great Flood so that they were drowned, and then made them to enter the Fire.

Again this accepted supplication is a warning against every oppressor, as Allah prohibits corruption and oppression between the people.

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The 4th accepted supplication of Prophet Noah

was to save himself and the believers who are with him.

The supplication is in Surat Al Shu'ara (26) V 117-118

The supplication

"(117) He said " My Lord ! Verily , my people have belied me. Therefore judge You between me and them and save me and those of the believers who are with me "

The answer : In surat Noah (71) - In Kersi (119)

" And we saved him and those with him in the Ladenship "

The event : in mentioned in Surat Noah (71) (105-116)

It is Allah's mercy to save the believers , who believe in Allah's Oneness as they are the blessing of Allah on the earth.

This is a supplication for every believer to save him from any harm of the human beings.

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Beside these 4 detailed answered supplications for prophet Noah, there are also 2 answered supplications which are mentioned briefly, let us know them:

In Surah AL-Anbiya - Verse (76 - 77)
(23)

and
In Surah As-Saffat (75 - 76)
(37)

Conclusion:

It is the Duaa to Allah, the way to the believer to have all his worries to be relieved, his hopes to become a reality, his weakness, oppression, and sadness to be healed and cured by the Power of the Allmighty, Allah, The Only One Who can answer our Duaa.

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
